Medicaid is different from Medicare. Medicare provides health insurance coverage for senior citizens and people with disabilities. The Medicare program is administered directly by the federal government, so it is managed consistently from state to state. By contrast, [Medicaid](#) works differently from one state to the next. That's because each state operates its own Medicaid program. But, *every* state offers some form of Medicaid coverage for addiction treatment.

Does Medicaid Pay for Drug and Alcohol Addiction Treatment?

Yes! The good news is that **Medicaid does pay for outpatient drug and alcohol addiction treatment**. Medicaid is a program that is funded by the state. This program can provide free or low-cost outpatient drug and alcohol addiction treatment to those who need it. While there are various Medicaid plans that have varying levels of eligibility, the rules for eligibility can change over time. This means that even if you were not eligible in the past, you might be eligible now.

In the past, people had trouble finding Medicaid addiction programs; however, since the Affordable Care Act (ACA) went into effect in 2010, Medicaid was required to cover most basic aspects of drug and alcohol rehab. Now, it is easier to find an addiction center that accepts Medicaid because this coverage is required.
