#### Alcohol Abuse Treatment

Those who drink alcohol without concern for the consequences suffer from alcohol abuse. This may happen when a person binge drinks, consumes alcohol uncontrollably after abstaining for a period of time, or tries to use alcohol as a coping mechanism. Although symptoms may vary, patterns to look out for include:

- Loss of interest in work, friends, and family
- Decline in social interactions
- Notable behavioral changes or mood swings
- Desire to drink alcohol excessively

If left unchecked, alcohol abuse will have long-term effects on a person's physical and mental health. Beyond the damage to a person's social life, this may include fatigue, insomnia, nausea, an increase in anxiety and the chance of liver disease, and a decline in memory retention and cognitive skills. Our outpatient alcohol treatment addresses both the patterns of consumption and the underlying issues that may have led to the drinking.

### **Drug and Substance Abuse Treatment**

People who have an uncontrollable urge to use drugs will suffer from brain changes that may become permanent. *Our approach to treatment asserts that the family plays a pivotal role in offering support and preventing relapses in behavior.* Working with those closest to the person using the drugs, we bring the addict and family together, strengthen the bonds between them, and *develop a customized plan that takes into account the family's dynamics*.

Our holistic treatment approach combines a *twelve-step program* and a spiritual approach that emphasizes the importance of family members in the recovery process. Some of the important elements include:

- Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (that helps a person understand, confront, and reject situations where there is a tendency to use drugs)
- Motivational Incentives (that offer positive alternatives to deter patients from using or returning to drugs)
- Multidimensional Therapy (that allows younger patients and family members to address the situation collaboratively)

#### **Prescription Drug Abuse Treatment**

Doctors prescribe certain medications to manage anxiety, pain, or other physiological or behavioral conditions. When taken as directed, these medications offer relief and maintain or improve an individual's health. When abused or taken by others, these same medications become harmful rather than beneficial. *National studies have indicated that abuse of prescribed medications is more of an epidemic than that of any other controlled substance except for marijuana*.

<u>Prescription drug abuse</u> cuts across all populations. People increasing their dosage, taking medications after the symptoms they needed them for disappear, or sharing them with others are reasons that prescription drug abuse has reached such high levels. Misuse occurs when an individual decides to take a medication in ways that differ from the directions on the prescription. Whether a person abuses or misuses the prescription, the results can be deadly.

Our treatment approach for the abuse or misuse of prescription drugs also combines the twelve-step program with an emphasis on spirituality. We work with families to strengthen the patient's support system and prevent relapses.
